The Southern New Hampshire Regional Planning Commission (SNHPC) will hold a meeting on its U.S. EPA brownfields grant on Thursday, May 5, 2016 from 3:00 to 4:00 p.m. in the conference room at SNHPC, located at 438 DuBuque Street, Manchester.

Brownfields are abandoned, idled, or underutilized properties where expansion, redevelopment, or reuse are complicated by real or perceived environmental contamination. The SNHPC has received a grant from the U.S. EPA to assist in assessment of the level of contamination on these properties – a key step in the process of reuse or redevelopment. NHDES and CRDC also have funding available to support Brownfields redevelopment projects.
