NH DOT 2019-2018 Ten-Year Transportation Improvement Plan Public Comment Hearings

The draft 2019-2028 NH DOT Ten-Year Transportation Improvement Plan has been released. In the SNHPC region, five of the top nine regional project priorities were included in the draft [TYP](#).

The draft will receive public comment at a series of hearings around the state, hosted by members of the Governor's Advisory Commission on Intermodal Transportation (GACIT). Attention MS4 Communities

October 14, 2017 - Nashua and Manchester Regional Stormwater Coalition Meeting - **9:00 AM** (*Nashua Regional Planning Commission Office, 9 Executive Park Dr., Merrimack, NH*)

The new MS4 permit (Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System) was released on January 18, 2017, and while the 2003 MS4 permit expired in 2008, it remains in effect until the coverage is obtained under the reissued permit in July 2018.

Communities will have less than a year to establish budgets and prepare. Five regional planning commissions (RPCs) are coordinating efforts to effectively and efficiently serve their communities that must respond to permit requirements. During this time, municipalities participating in the regional stormwater coalitions are creating roadmaps of steps needed to comply with the new permit.

Southern NH Planning Commission

The SNHPC region includes the City of Manchester and the towns of Auburn, Bedford, Candia, Chester, Deerfield, Derry, Francestown, Goffstown, Hooksett, Londonderry, New Boston, Weare and Windham. The main functions of SNHPC are to increase communication; promote intergovernmental cooperation and coordination between planning boards and local officials; promote coordinated development of the region; prepare and adopt regional plans, including policies and strategies for the region; and perform other acts or functions as deemed appropriate to fulfill its duties.

SNHPC is governed by a Board of Commissioners, 48 local representatives from our 14 member communities. The Commissioners are appointed by the governing bodies of the member municipalities upon the recommendation of their respective planning boards, as outlined in RSA 36:46. An Executive Committee, consisting of 14 commissioners, is elected from the membership of the full Board of Commissioners to provide overall policy direction and guidance, and to administer the Commission's financial and operational affairs. An Executive Director is appointed by the Commission to manage and supervise the day-to-day operations of the Commission and its staff under the general direction provided by the Executive Committee and the Board of Commissioners.
